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The Quality of Life Foundation (QoLF) is a national 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization that addresses the unmet needs of caregivers, children and family members who provide daily, substantial care for catastrophically wounded, ill or injured veterans. Through the *Wounded Veteran Family Care Program (WVFCP)*, QoLF provides services to the caregivers and family members, whose lives have forever been changed. In FY 2015-2016, the QoLF supported nearly 150 families, totaling over 637 family members, and resolved over 500 unique unmet needs.

Eligibility for Services

- All veterans, all branches of military service, National Guard and Reserves
- Veteran has a service-connected wound, injury, or illness
- Veteran is in the need of a family caregiver for basic and or instrumental activities of daily living

Types of Services

Rather than offering a defined list of assistance we tailor our services for each family. Through the WVFCP we offer a holistic approach to our services addressing multiple challenges that a family may experience. We offer non-traditional assistance, through partnership and advocacy, that is critical in supporting the financial, emotional, physical, mental and social well-being of the caregiver, children and veteran. Common needs that improve the quality of life of the caregiver family include:

- Caregiver respite and child care services
- Extra-curricular activities for minor children
- Home modifications/repair and lawn care
- Financial support for auto repair, moving expenses and educational assistance
- Personal care support (medical/dental appointments)
- Counseling services and much more

The Quality of Life Foundation works closely with VA Caregiver Support Coordinators, the veteran's VA or military case managers, community resources and advocates, and other veteran services organizations to ensure that our support complements and leverages the support provided by other resources.
